Kazuma san became a potter in his father's footsteps. After spending 4-5 years in Okayama studying Bizen ware, he returned to Karatsu to work alongside his father. Starting with tradition as a foundation, the process of making something from nothing, in a way that weaves the sensibilities of the creator into an object that brings fullness into a person's life, is the guiding principle at Sashiyamagama.

Both father and son are seasoned artisans of few words. They want to make good work that answers the needs of the customer. The warm, gentle, rustic charm of Karatsu ware is reflected in the personalities of these two potters. Going forward, to complement their tableware, they want to try their hand at tea ceremony ware as well.
