Yasunaga san opened his studio and kiln at its current location in 2008. Using techniques and clay that complement his kiln and firing style, each piece of work is made with great care, one by one. Sometimes, he doesn't care for the work that comes out of the kiln, even though there is nothing wrong with the firing or glazes. Constantly asking himself the reason for this, he continues to dig deeper, striving to make pots that speak to the heart of the user.

Recently, he has begun to feel the need to make Karatsu ware that is attractive also to people who aren't particularly interested in ceramics. His unseen thoughts and feelings manifest in the pots. The spirit of seeking gives Yasunaga san's pots their appeal.
