Ignoring trends, he doesn't just want to make work to please customers, but to make work he believes in. He hopes to bring back some forgotten aspects of the Karatsu aesthetic. Recently, he has been less focused on Karatsu ware, and is challenging himself in other directions. His free thinking and straightforward nature is magnetic.
